Mobile Privacy Statement

Collection and Use of Mobile Numbers

Mobile phone numbers are only collected through secure, opt-in methods, such as registration forms or consent-based sign-ups. We will use your mobile number exclusively for purposes related to relevant communications from CyberCore Technologies.

Privacy and Security

Information Collection and Use

We collect various types of information to provide and improve our Site to you.

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using our Site, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you (“Personal Data”). Personally identifiable information or Personal Data may include, but is not limited to:

Cookies and Usage Data

Usage Data

Tracking & Cookies Data

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our Site and hold certain information.

Cookies are files with a small amount of data that may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your device. Tracking technologies also used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Site.

You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may be unable to use some portions of our Site.

Examples of Cookies we use:

- **Session Cookies.** We use Session Cookies to operate our Site.
- **Preference Cookies.** We use Preference Cookies to remember your preferences and various settings.
- **Security Cookies.** We use Security Cookies for security purposes.
